- Cantwell Cliffs (740) 385-6842. Situated on a high outcropping of Black Hand sandstone, Cantwell Cliffs is in one of the most remote areas of Hocking Hills State Park
- **Cedar Falls.** (740) 385-6842. Features the greatest volume of water of all the falls in Hocking County, with water plunging 50 feet. The most photographed waterfalls in Ohio.
- **Conkles** Hollow Nature Preserve (614) 265-6561. Sheer cliffs of Black Hand sandstone that rise nearly 200 feet above the valley floor.

From the West:

- From Lancaster, take US-33 E for 7.6 miles after the 33 by-pass merge on the east side of Lancaster.
- When you see Rockbridge Flea Market and Amish stores, prepare to turn left in a 1/2 mile.
- Turn left on TWP RD 567.
- Make an immediate left on Titan Rd.
- Veer left at the "Yield" sign, to proceed on Darl Rd (do not turn up the hill).
- Proceed to the end of Darl Rd., and your destination is at the end of the turn around, veering slightly right to go up the hill. It is a concrete drive way. It is steep, but safe.

From the East:

- Follow US-33 from Logan wast toward Lancaster. Prepare to turn right immediately after the rest stop.
- Turn right on TWP RD 567.
- Make an immediate left on Titan Rd.
- Veer left at the "Yield" sign, to proceed on Darl Rd (do not turn up the hill).
- Proceed to the end of Darl Rd., and your destination is at the end of the turn around, veering slightly right to go up the hill. It is a concrete drive way. It is steep, but safe.
